About Us

MigrantWell Singapore (MWS) provides essential dental, psychological, and rehabilitative care for migrant workers in Singapore, addressing gaps in existing healthcare plans.

Born at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, MWS was launched in 2021 by the SBF Foundation in collaboration with two Founding Donors, the estates of Khoo Teck Puat and Ng Teng Fong.

Seed funding from the Founding Donors enabled:

- The set up of the **St. Andrew's Migrant Worker Medical Centre (SAMWMC)** at Penjuru Recreation Center under Manpower Ministry's Primary Care Plan (PCP).
- The establishment of the **MigrantWell Welfare Fund** to fulfil unmet care needs of migrant workers beyond the PCP.



Championing Holistic Care

As a charity with IPC status, we focus on providing accessible and inclusive care through collaboration with our partners:

Dental Services: The top three services are **dental fillings, gum treatment,** and **dental extractions.** MWS also promotes preventive dental health of migrant workers through its partners.

Physiotherapy Services: Migrant workers seek physiotherapy treatments for pain in their lower back, neck, knees, and shoulders.

Psychological Care Services: Migrant workers receive counselling, casework support, or mental health education. Common issues requiring counselling include anxiety due to medical conditions, and relationship issues with colleagues, roommates, and family.

Medical Services: SAMWMC offers subsidised services such as medical examinations, vaccinations, telemedicine consultations, and follow-ups.

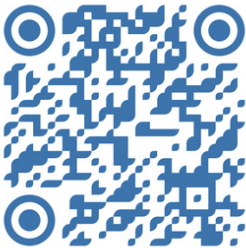
